2. Apologies for absence

- 3. Actions arising from previous meetings.
- a. (2/6/15 Para 9) 50th anniversary article. In hand, draft written. **Action Mark/Steve.**
- b. (2/6/15 Para 10). BOF Insurance and cover of Scout Groups and casual attendees. Actioned. Juniors need to be BO members as School Insurance will not necessarily cover them. Cover needs to be actively encouraged Junior BO membership is modest at £2. Action: Sue to discuss with Jill Prowse.
